Lordstown Village Council Regular Meeting

(WHEREAS, the regular meeting before the Lordstown Village Council commenced on Monday, November 16, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. and proceedings were as follows:)

MAYOR HILL: I call the meeting to order. Please stand and join us in the Lord's Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

(Lord's Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag)

MAYOR HILL: Bill, roll call, please.
MR. BLANK: Mayor Hill?
MAYOR HILL: Present.
