ORDINANCE NO. 14-2026

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE NO. 13-2025 CREATING TEMPORARY, SEASONAL, PART-TIME SUMMER POSITIONS WITHIN THE STREETS, PARKS AND BUILDINGS DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN FOR THE 2026 SEASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I: That there is hereby created temporary, seasonal, part-time summer positions within the Street, Parks and Buildings Department of the Village of Lordstown.

Section II: That persons hired to fill these positions shall be paid at the rate of Thirteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$13.00) and shall not work in excess of **thirty (30)** hours per week.

Section III: That all persons hired for these positions shall not be entitled to any fringe benefits as such positions are part-time, temporary and seasonal positions.

Section IV: That all persons hired for these positions shall have a valid operator's license (driver's license) and the duties, hours of work and job responsibilities shall be assigned by the Street Commissioner/Parks, Grounds and Buildings Superintendent.

Section V: That all persons hired for these positions shall be recommended by the Street Commissioner/Parks, Grounds and Buildings Superintendent, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Village Council.

Section VI: That there is hereby created eight (8) temporary, seasonal, part-time summer positions within the Streets, Parks, and Buildings Department of the Village of Lordstown.


Section VII: That this Ordinance is in effect upon passage and ending November 30, 2026 for all temporary, seasonal, part-time summer positions.


Section VIII: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the

public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be implemented in a timely manner to ensure the efficient, timely, and adequate staffing of the Village of Lordstown's personnel needs.

Section IX: That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
