**ORDINANCE NO. 22-2025**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN TO ENACT CONSENT LEGISLATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5521.01 AUTHORIZING THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROCEED WITH ANY AND ALL NECESSARY SYSTEMATIC 2-LANE SIGN REPLACEMENTS ON STATE ROUTE 45 WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, PID NO. 112198, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section I:** That the Ohio Department of Transportation proposes to perform systematic 2-lane sign replacements on State Route 45 within the Village of Lordstown.

**Section II:** That Ohio Revised Code Section 5521.01 requires that the Director of Transportation shall first request and receive Consent Legislation from the Village of Lordstown prior to proceeding with performing systematic 2-lane sign replacements on State Route 45 within the Village of Lordstown.

**Section III:** That in furtherance of this objective, the Ohio Department of Transportation has proffered legislation for consideration by the Council of the Village of Lordstown, to-wit: "Preliminary Legislation" and a form certifying the enactment of such legislation, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, the terms of which are incorporated by reference and made a part of this Ordinance.


**Section IV:** That the Council of the Village of Lordstown hereby authorizes the adoption of the Consent Legislation, to-wit: the Preliminary Legislation and the form of certification, **Exhibit A**.


**Section V:** That the Mayor and Clerk are furthermore authorized and directed to execute the Consent Legislation, together with any and all other documents which may be necessary to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Ordinance.

**Section VI:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the Consent Legislation must be enacted in a timely manner.

**Section VII:** That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.

The following is Ordinance enacted by the Village of Lordstown of Trumbull  
(Ordinance/Resolution) (Local Public Agency)  
County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

**SECTION I - Project Description**

WHEREAS, the (LPA/STATE) has identified the need for the described project:

Systematic 2-lane sign replacements on SR45 in the Village of Lordstown.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Lordstown of Trumbull County, Ohio.

**SECTION II - Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

**SECTION III - Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

**SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement**

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of way costs include eligible utility costs.

**SECTION V - Maintenance**

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

**SECTION VI - Authority to Sign**

The Village Clerk of said Village of Lordstown is hereby empowered  
(Contractual Agent) (LPA)  
on behalf of the Village of Lordstown to enter into contracts with the Director of  
(LPA)  
Transportation which is necessary to complete the above described project.
