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ORDINANCE NO. 3-2026

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN TO ENACT PRELIMINARY PARTICIPATORY LEGISLATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5521.01 AUTHORIZING THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROCEED WITH ANY AND ALL NECESSARY RESURFACING, PID NO. 117400, SALT SPRINGS ROAD FROM SR 45 TO THE LORDSTOWN EASTERN CORP LIMIT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I: That the Ohio Department of Transportation proposes to perform resurfacing to Salt Springs Road from SR 45 to the Lordstown Eastern Corp Limit within the Village of Lordstown.

Section II: That Ohio Revised Code Section 5521.01 requires that the Director of Transportation shall first request and receive Preliminary Participatory Legislation from the Village of Lordstown prior to proceeding with performing resurfacing Salt Springs Road from SR 45 to the Lordstown Eastern Corp Limit within the Village of Lordstown.

Section III: That in furtherance of this objective, the Ohio Department of Transportation has proffered legislation for consideration by the Council of the Village of Lordstown, to-wit: "Preliminary Participatory Legislation" and a form certifying the enactment of such legislation, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, the terms of which are incorporated by reference and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section IV: That the Council of the Village of Lordstown hereby authorizes the adoption of the Preliminary Participatory Legislation and the form of certification, **Exhibit A**.

Section V: That the Mayor, Clerk, and President of Council are furthermore authorized and directed to execute the Preliminary Participatory Legislation, together with any and all other documents which may be necessary to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Ordinance.

Section VI: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the

The following is Ordinance 3-2026 enacted by the Village of Lordstown of Trumbull
(An Ordinance/a Resolution) (Local Public Agency)
County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Resurfacing Salt Springs Rd from SR 45 to the Lordstown Eastern Corp Limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Lordstown of Trumbull County, Ohio.
(LPA)

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA agrees to participate in the cost of construction at One Hundred Percent (100%) less any Federal funds with a Twenty Percent (20%) match applied to the project.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Exhibit A

SECTION IV - Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION V - Authority to Sign

The Clerk of said Village of Lordstown is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Lordstown to enter into contracts with ODOT pre-qualified consultants for the preliminary engineering phase of the Project and to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Upon the request of ODOT, the Clerk is also empowered to assign all rights, title, and interests of the Village of Lordstown to ODOT arising from any agreement with its consultant in order to allow ODOT to direct additional or corrective work, recover damages due to errors or omissions, and to exercise all other contractual rights and remedies afforded by law or equity.

The LPA agrees that if Federal Funds are used to pay the cost of any consultant contract, the LPA shall comply with 23 CFR 172 in the selection of its consultant and the administration of the consultant contract. Further the LPA agrees to incorporate ODOT's "Specifications for Consulting Services" as a contract document in all of its consultant contracts. The LPA agrees to require, as a scope of services clause, that all plans prepared by the consultant must conform to ODOT's current design standards and that the consultant shall be responsible for ongoing consultant involvement during the construction phase of the Project. The LPA agrees to include a completion schedule acceptable to ODOT and to assist ODOT in rating the consultant's performance through ODOT's Consultant Evaluation System.
