ORDINANCE NO. 36-2025

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN TO
SELL TO THE ESTATE OF THEODORE DREWEK OFFICER
DREWEK'S DUTY HANDGUN WEAPON FOR THE SUM OF ONE
DOLLAR (\$1.00) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section I: That the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association and Village of Lordstown, Ohio (Patrolmen-Sergeants) effective January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2027, Article 15 "Retirement and Disability Pensions", Section 2 provides, in part, that upon retirement of a full-time officer (provided that such officer has served a minimum of ten (10) years with the Lordstown Village Police Department), the retiring officer shall be permitted to purchase his/her duty handgun weapon from the Village of Lordstown for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00). The retiring officer must complete the appropriate paperwork acknowledging the purchase of the handgun and to register a transfer of ownership of said handgun.

Section II: That Officer Theodore Drewek, having served a minimum of ten years, planned on purchasing his duty handgun from the Village of Lordstown for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), but passed away on March 12, 2025.

Section III: That the Estate of Theodore Drewek has made a formal request for the purchase of said duty handgun and the Village has issued an invoice (copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the terms of which are incorporated by reference and made a part of this Ordinance).


Section IV: That the Chief of Police and the Safety Committee recommend to Village Council that the Estate of Theodore Drewek be permitted to purchase Officer Drewek's police duty weapon, Glock Model 22 Gen4, .40cal; Serial No. SBB511 from the Village of Lordstown for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and that this decision shall be non-precedent setting.

Section V: That Council of the Village of Lordstown concurs with the recommendation of Chief of Police and the Safety Committee and hereby authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to sell to the Estate of Theodore Drewek the above-referenced police duty handgun weapon from the Village of Lordstown for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).

Section VI: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to effectuate a timely transfer to the Estate and avoid unnecessarily delaying proceedings in Probate Court.

Section VII: That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
