

ORDINANCE NO. 58-2025

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN CLERK TO PAY DARREN BIGGS AND MIKE FUCHILLA ALL THEIR VACATION EXCEPT THE FORTY HOURS WHICH IS COVERED IN THE MASTER BENEFITS ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I: That the Masters Benefits Ordinance at Section 16 "Vacations" (C) provides as follows:

"An employee may carry over into the following year up to forty (40) hours of unused vacation, paid at the rate of pay prevailing at the time used. In the event of death of an employee, any carry-over vacation pay shall accrue to the decedent's estate. If the resulting vacation imposes a scheduling burden in the Department which would create the need for the hiring of additional employees, the Department shall not be required to tack this carry-over to the current entitlement."

Section II: That, because of the shortage of manpower, Darren Biggs and Mike Fuchilla were unable to take all of their vacation for the year 2025.

Section III: That the Council of the Village of Lordstown hereby authorizes the Clerk of the Village of Lordstown to pay Darren Biggs and Mike Fuchilla all of their vacation for the year 2025 (except the forty hours covered in the Master Benefits Ordinance), payable in December 2025.

Section IV: That payment for Darren Biggs and Mike Fuchilla shall be made from Account Nos. 601.353.55100 and 602.353.55100.

Section V: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that the Village Clerk must satisfy payroll commitments in a timely manner.

Section VI: That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
