ORDINANCE NO. 63-2025

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 57-2025 TO PROHIBIT THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF DATA CENTERS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I: That on November 3, 2025, the Council of the Village of Lordstown enacted Ordinance No. 57-2025 to impose a prohibition on new permits for any data center located within the Village of Lordstown.

Section II: That, said Ordinance will go into effect on December 3, 2025.


Section III: That, after careful reconsideration and in conjunction with the advice from legal counsel, the Council of the Village of Lordstown no longer wishes to proceed with the ban as proposed.


Section IV: That the Council of the Village of Lordstown hereby repeals Ordinance No. 57-2025 in its entirety to become effective upon passage.

Section V: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, to timely conserve Village resources, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is repealed prior to the effective date.

Section VI: That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
