ORDINANCE NO. 7-2026

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE NO. 44-2025 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT WITH THE TRUMBULL COUNTY ENGINEER, 650 NORTH RIVER ROAD, N.W., WARREN, OHIO, TO PURCHASE AN ADDITIONAL 420 TONS OF SALT AND TO ADD ANY FUEL CHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PURCHASE OF SALT FOR THE 2025-2026 WINTER SEASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That, pursuant to Ordinance No. 44-2025, the Village of Lordstown purchased approximately two thousand eight hundred (2,800) tons of salt at the price of Forty-Eight and 99/00 (\$48.99) per ton for the 2025-2026 winter season.

Section 2: That the Streets, Sidewalks, Public Parks, Buildings, Grounds, and General Improvement Committee recommends that the Village of Lordstown *amend* the Agreement with the Trumbull County Engineer to purchase an additional four hundred twenty (420) tons of salt and to add any fuel charges in connection with the purchase of salt.

Section 3: That the Council of the Village of Lordstown concurs with the recommendation of the Streets, Sidewalks, Public Parks, Buildings, Grounds, and General Improvement Committee and hereby authorizes the purchase of an additional four hundred twenty (420) tons of salt and the addition of any fuel charges in connection with the purchase of salt under the Agreement for the 2025-2026 winter season.

Section 4: That payment for said material shall be made from the 201.335.53242 Snow Account of the M & R Fund.


Section 5: That all other provisions of Ordinance 44-2025 not otherwise affected by this amended Ordinance shall remain enforceable in accordance with its terms.


Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be effective by

salt purchasing season.

Section 7: That the passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
