A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 9-2010 WHICH CONFERRED THE HONORARY NAME OF "CHEVROLET-UAW PARKWAY" ON A PORTION OF HALLOCK-YOUNG ROAD FROM ELLSWORTH BAILEY ROAD TO TOD AVENUE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, COUNTY OF TRUMBULL, STATE OF OHIO:	
Section I: That on July 15, 2010, Council of the Village of Lordstown enacted Resolution No. 9-2010 which conferred the honorary name of "Chevrolet-UAW Parkway" on a portion of Hallock-Young Road from Ellsworth Bailey Road to Tod Avenue within the Village of Lordstown and directed the Street Superintendent to place three signs along Hallock-Young Road acknowledging the honorary name of Chevrolet-UAW Parkway.	
Section II: That the Council of the Village of Lordstown hereby repeals Resolution No. 9-2010 in its entirety to become effective immediately upon passage.	
Section III: That the Street Superintendent of the Village of Lordstown is hereby directed to remove the three signs along Hallock Young Road which acknowledges the honorary name of Chevrolet-UAW Parkway.	
Section IV: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that time is of the essence to avoid confusion for vehicle traffic.	
Section V: That the passage of this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
