4. \_\_\_\_\_ A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF INCOME TAXES THAT MAY BE ASSESSED AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT FOR PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT, USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT AND EMS SAFETY SERVICES, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT FIRE AND EMS PERSONNEL IN THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AN ADDITIONAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
