1. _____ AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN A PROPOSED ADDITIONAL ONE HALF PERCENT (0.50%) INCOME AND NET PROFITS TAX PROVIDED FOR IN CHAPTER 181 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN RAISING SAID RATE FROM THE CURRENT ONE PERCENT (1.0%) TO ONE AND HALF PERCENT (1.50%) WITH SUCH ADDITIONAL FUNDS RAISED THEREBY BEING DEDICATED TO FIRE AND EMS SAFETY SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

2. _____ A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF INCOME TAXES THAT MAY BE ASSESSED AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT FOR PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT, USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT AND EMS SAFETY SERVICES, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT FIRE AND EMS PERSONNEL IN THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AN ADDITIONAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
