Next week, we are excited to begin construction of a new and enhanced landfill gas collection and treatment system at the Lordstown landfill. We have worked closely with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Trumbull County Combined Health District over the past year to design and permit the installation of the gas system which will help collect, control, and treat gasses that are generated in the landfill.

Our team working at the landfill, along with our third party contractor constructing the new gas system, are committed to protecting the environment and the community we work in. While we understand that odors during construction may be elevated, the purpose of this new gas treatment system is to improve odors in the surrounding community.

Included in this envelope is a one-page informational sheet that will provide you with more details on what is happening at the landfill and resources you can use if you have any questions or concerns. We expect that these upgrades will meet the needs of the landfill and community for years to come. We appreciate your patience over the next few months as we work to improve our operations.

# PROGRESS IS COMING YOUR WAY

We are working hard to make improvements at the Lordstown landfill that will make a positive change for the long-term, but there may be odors associated with these changes in the short-term. We want to ensure you know what to expect.



## IS THAT A DRILL RIG?

Yes it is! During construction, a drill rig will be temporarily positioned near the top of the landfill and along the northern slopes. Typical waste acceptance operations will continue during construction.

There will be no increase in offsite traffic with the exception of a few extra passenger vehicles from the construction crew.

The treatment system is enclosed, meaning you will not see an open flame or gasses. The treatment system will be positioned in the northwest corner of the landfill.

These efforts will enhance odor control & reduce fugitive emissions of landfill gases beginning upon completion of construction of the gas system and continuing through the entire life of the landfill.

As the landfill expands within the current permitted footprint, the gas collection system will also expand to ensure the efficient collection of landfill gas from future areas of the landfill.

## THE DETAILS



### WHEN

Starting **May 31, 2022** for approximately **3 months**

M-F 6:00 am - 5:30 pm / Saturday 6:00 am - 3:00 pm

There will be no construction on Sundays or legal holidays.



### WHAT

Construction will consist of drilling wells near the top of the landfill and along the north slopes of the landfill. A pipe and treat system will be installed to burn off collected gases in a safe and efficient manner, thus reducing and eliminating offensive odors.



### THAT MEANS

Throughout the construction period, elevated odors may occur during the day when construction is ongoing.

Lordstown landfill plans to operate the odor control misting system along the north side of the landfill to help mitigate offensive odors. At the end of each working day, precautions will be taken to help reduce gas emissions during the evening, including covering any open wells or areas with soil & applying an odor neutralizing agent.
