1. _____ AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 59-2022 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN TO PAY THE SUM OF \$270,385.58, TO-WIT: (1) FIFTY PERCENT OF INCOME TAX COLLECTED FROM TJX HOMEGOODS EMPLOYEE PAYROLL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 (\$157,270.25) AND (2) FIFTY PERCENT OF INCOME TAX COLLECTED FROM TJX HOMEGOODS CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYEE PAYROLL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 (\$113,115.33) PURSUANT TO AN INCOME TAX SHARING AGREEMENT WHICH THE VILLAGE HAS ENACTED WITH THE LORDSTOWN BOARD OF EDUCATION TO SHARE INCOME TAXES GENERATED FROM TJX HOMEGOODS IN TWO INSTALLMENTS OF \$135,192.79 EACH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
