## Priscilla Detre Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2021 by Edward Detre and family. As a woman of the 1960s, Priscilla believed she should be able to stand on her own and be financially independent. Nursing was the profession that she believed would allow her to do this.

Priscilla was a member of the last graduating class of the Cleveland Mount Sinai hospital RN diploma program in 1970. After graduating, she worked for St. Joseph's Hospital of Warren on their step-down unit from Coronary and Intensive Care. Her position was Staff Nurse and Charge Nurse as needed. She did this for over 20 years, primarily on the midnight shift.

As a student at Mount Sinai she had an opportunity to learn about the very beginnings of dialysis and was fascinated. Twenty years later, she had the opportunity to go to work for St. Elizabeth's outpatient dialysis and took it. Shortly thereafter, she took a position with CDC Center for Dialysis Care in Cleveland and worked for them for over 20 years. Priscilla enjoyed the long-term relationship she had with her dialysis patients and completed her 45-year career as a dialysis nurse.

### Eligibility:

- For undergraduate students majoring in nursing.
- Preference given to Lordstown graduates.


### Terms:


